


ELECTRICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Note: The above model numbers are basic models. They may be followed by letters <u>L</u>, <u>D</u>, or ending with an <u>S</u>.

HOW TO INSTALL UNIT:

- 1. Place cabinet on level floor.
- 2. Plug cord end into proper wall outlet.



HOW TO START UNIT:


- 1. Turn the POWER switch on. The *yellow* light will turn on.
- 2. Turn thermostat to #7.
- 3. Preheat cabinet for 60 minutes.
- 4. Put food into cabinet.
- 5. Turn thermostat to #8 and close door.

No. 8 setting = approx. 185^{\circ}F(85^{\circ}C)
No. 6 setting = approx. 160^{\circ}F(71^{\circ}C)
No. 4 setting = approx. 130^{\circ}F(54^{\circ}C)
```

Proper food holding temperature is 140°F (60°C) or higher.

TO TURN OFF UNIT:

Push the POWER switch off. The *yellow* light will go out.

HOW TO CLEAN THE CABINET:

WARNING *BEFORE* cleaning the cabinet:

- 1. Allow cabinet to cool.
- 2. Remove Hot unit from cabinet.
- 3. Do NOT use abrasives or harsh chemicals.

Cleaning Notes:

- 1. Wipe up spills as soon as possible.
- 2. Clean cabinet regularly to avoid heavy dirt build-up.
- 3. Make a test spot with cleaner.
- 4. Follow manufacturer's directions on cleaner.
- 5. Do not mix cleaners.
- 6. Avoid drips and splashes.

	DIRT	Mild detergent* and hot water, or mild abrasive cleaner.	 Use soft, damp cloth. Rinse with hot water. Wipe dry. 	
STAINLESS STEEL		Steam (no strong alkaline additive)1. Rinse after steam clear 2. Wipe dry.		
BANQUET CABINET	FINGERPRINTS,	Chemical oven cleaner for aluminum.	Follow oven cleaner manufacturer's directions.	
	GREASE OIL	Mild abrasive cleaner; oily or waxy cleaner.	Apply with soft, clean cloth.	
	WATER SPOTS	Mild abrasive cleaner.	 Wipe with damp cloth. Rinse and dry. 	

NOTE: Gaskets are removable for cleaning.

TROUBLE-SHOOTING CHART:

FAILURE	POSSIBLE CAUSE
1. Yellow light at switch does NOT light	1a. Circuit breaker/fuse to wall outlet is blown.1b. Cord is unplugged from wall outlet.
	1c. Switch is "OFF".
2. Unit does not heat.	2a. Thermostat set too low or is "OFF".2b. Switch is "OFF".
3. Unit gets too hot or won't shut off.	3a. Defective electrical parts. UNPLUG UNIT FROM WALL OUTLET.
4. Blower does not work or make noise.	4a. Defective blower.

If cause is none of the above, refer to our list of Authorized Service Centers, FL-1400.
